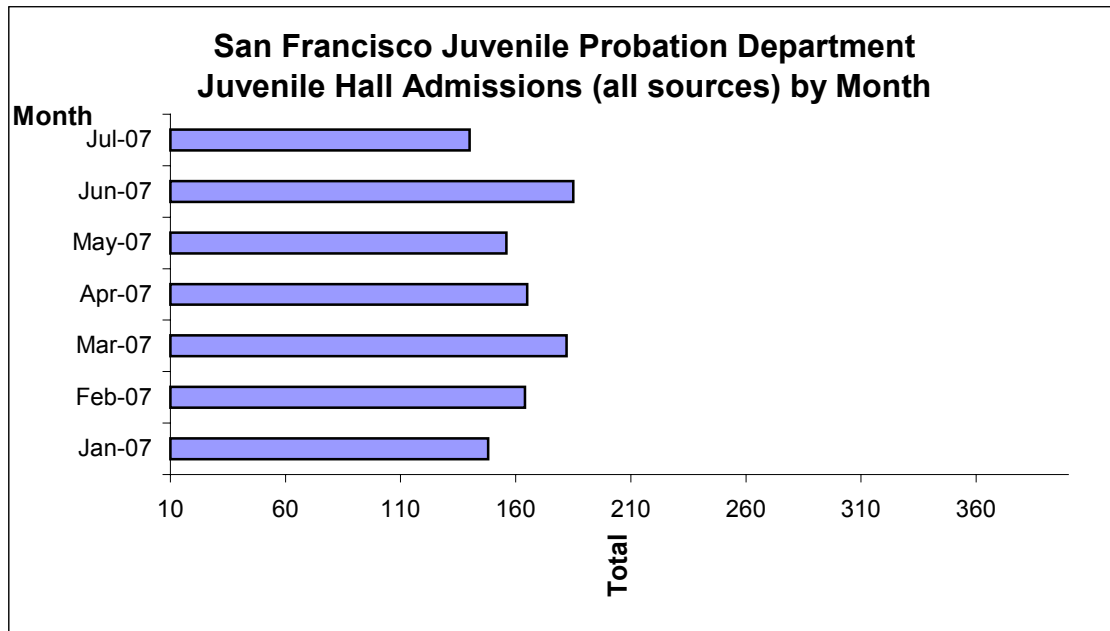
Bay Area Resident Juvenile Hall Comparison

(2004-2006)**

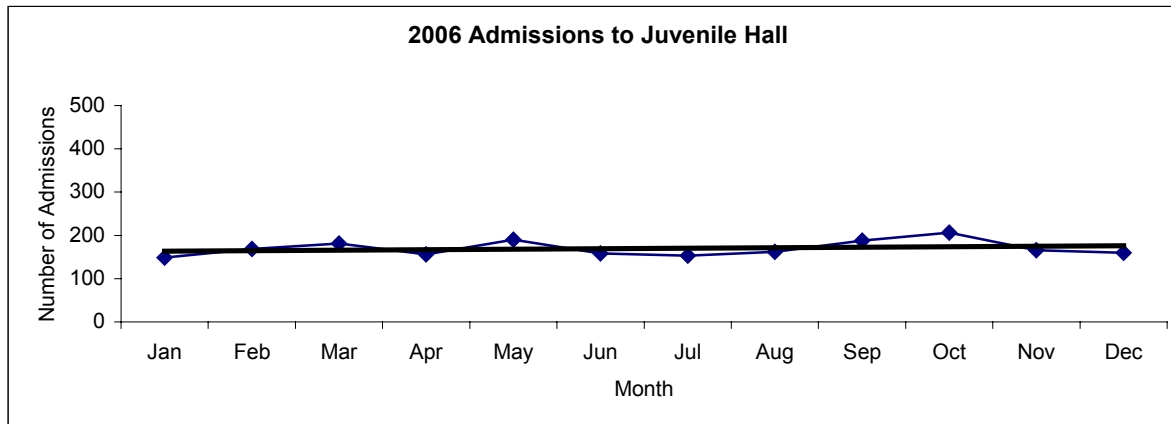

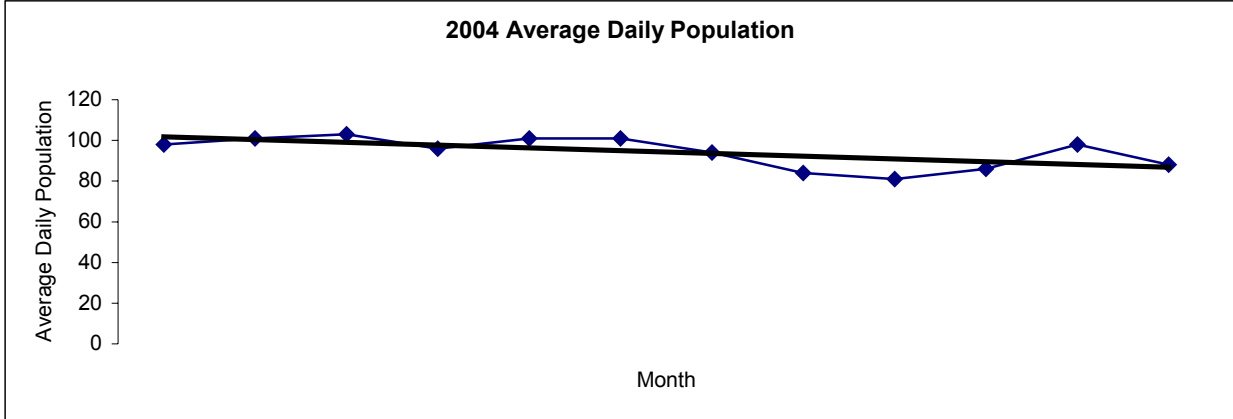

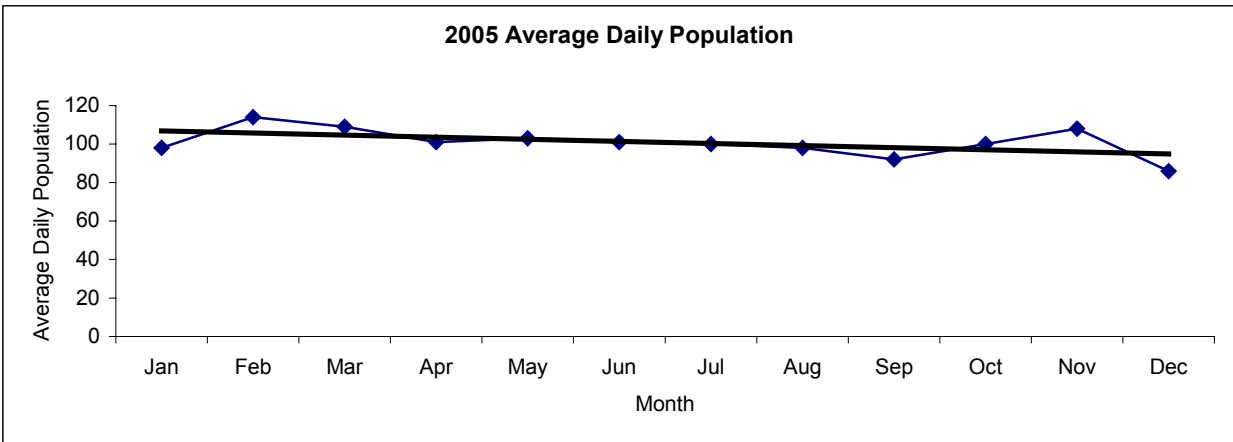
