REVISED **NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY** **OF DRAFT SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO SAN FRANCISCO'S** **2009-2010 ACTION PLAN**

The Mayor's Office of Housing (MOH) is proposing to amend San Francisco's 2009-2010 Action Plan to include \$2.5 million in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for economic stimulus activities. These funds are prior year CDBG dollars and are aligned with the general purposes of stimulus dollars issued through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The Draft Substantial Amendment to San Francisco's 2009-2010 Action Plan will be available for public review and comment from October 1, 2009 through October 30, 2009.

The 2009-2010 Action Plan outlines community development and housing strategies and priorities that will be addressed with four federal funding sources, including CDBG, and identifies projects that receive funding through the four federal programs during the program year.

During the 30-day comment period the draft amendment will be available to review electronically on MOH's main website at www.sfgov.org/moh and its Community Development Division's website at www.sfgov.org/moci. Print copies will also be available at the following locations:
