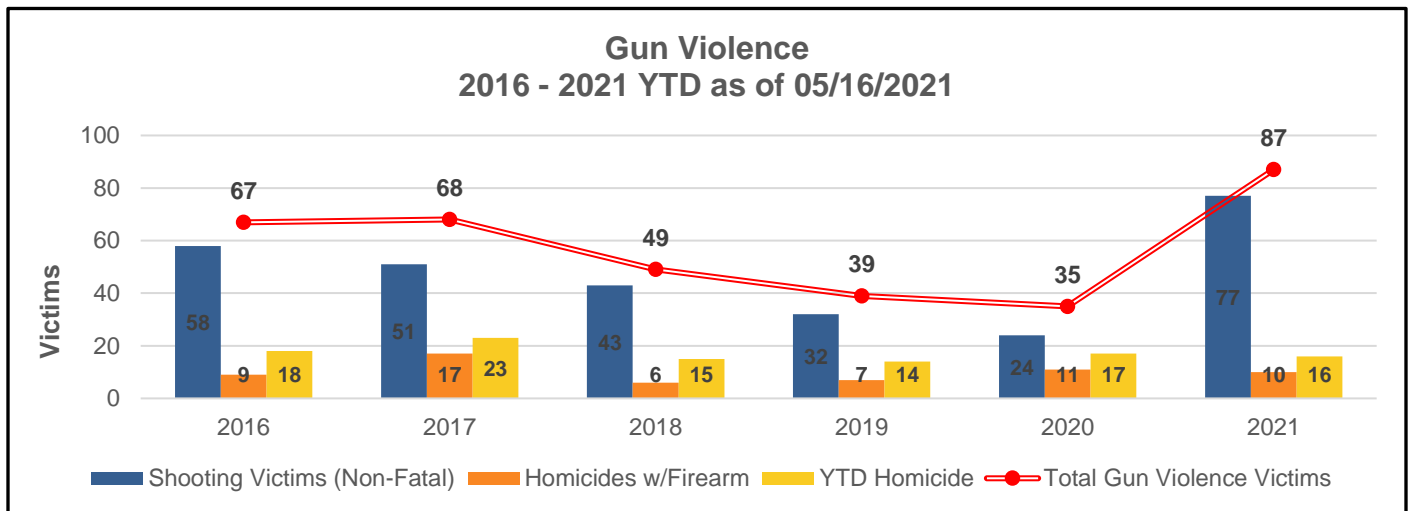

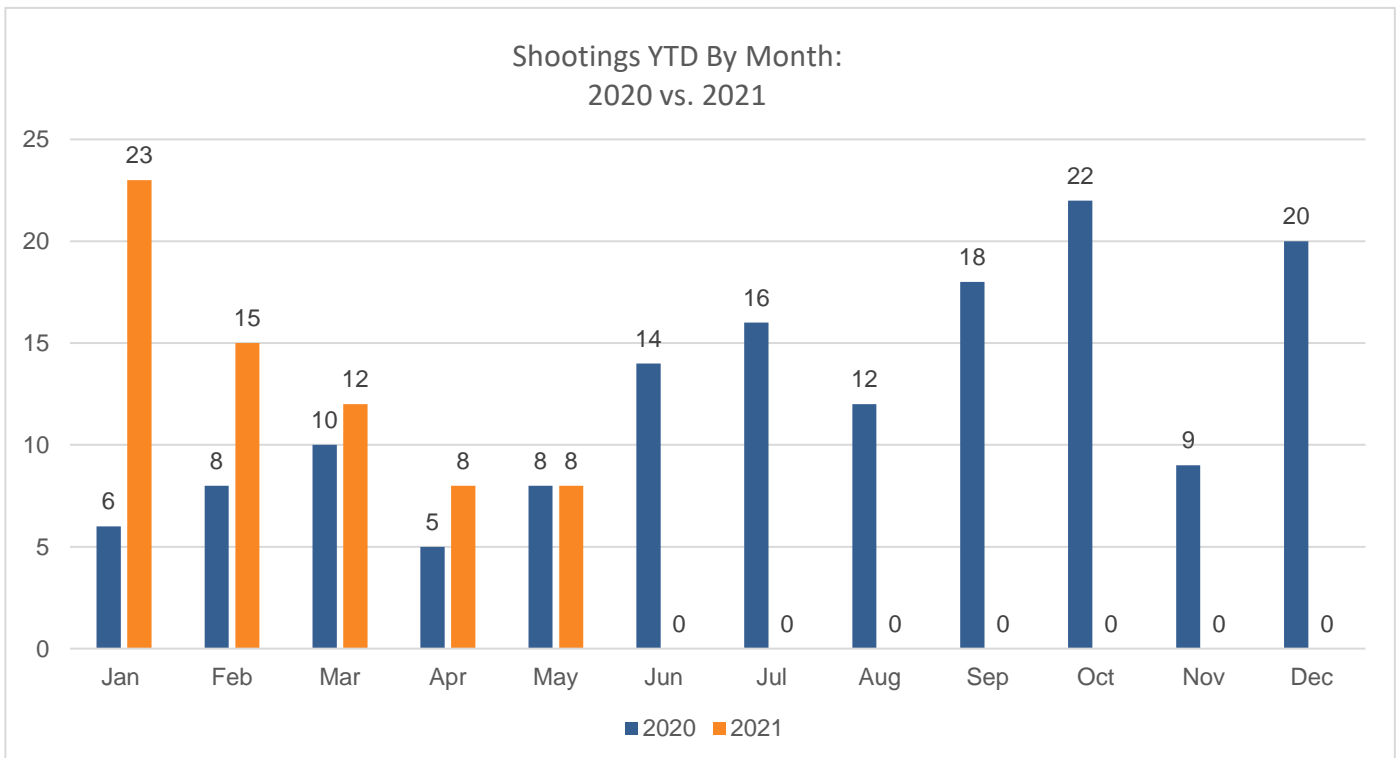

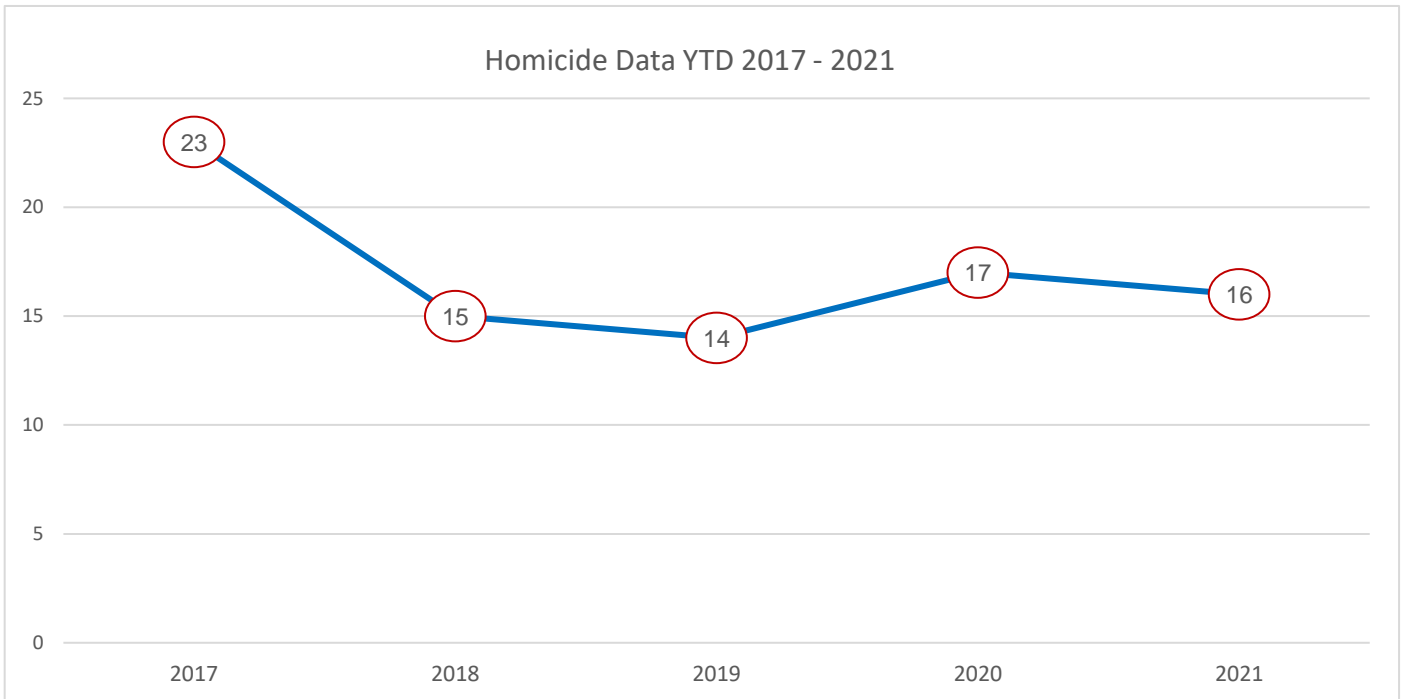
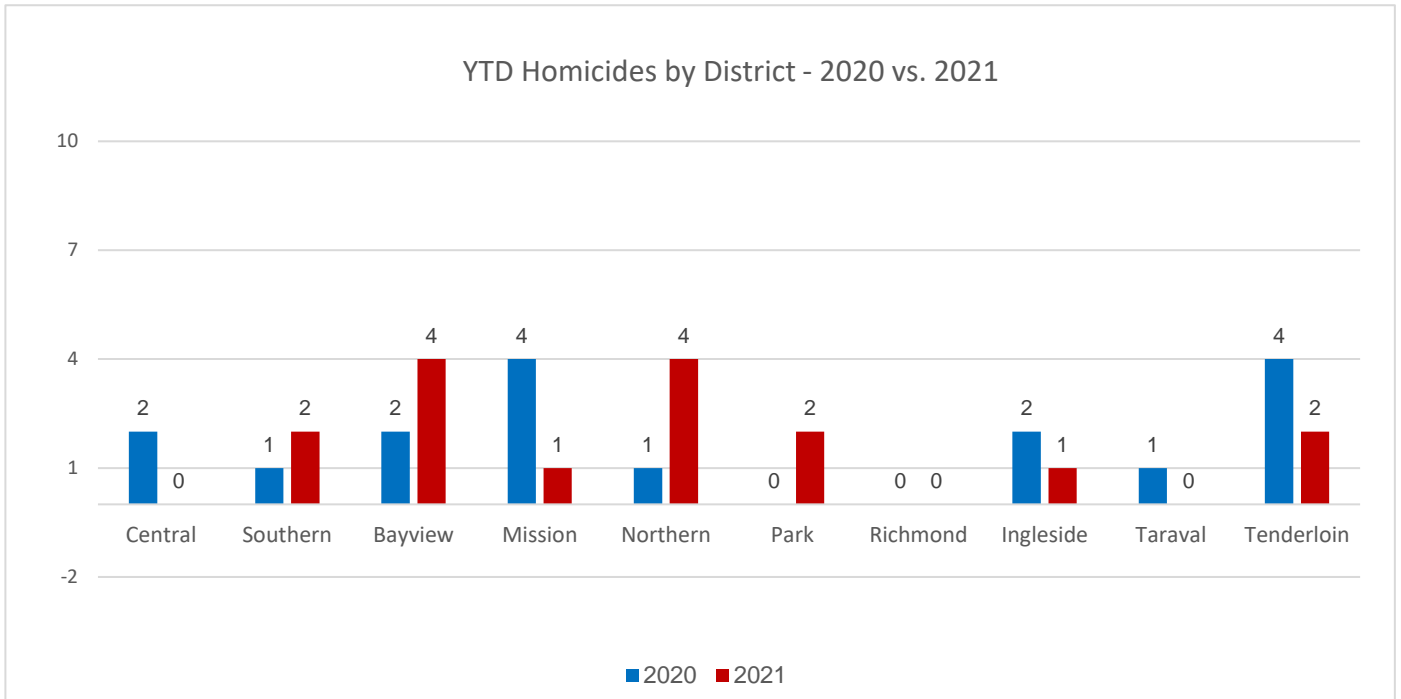
GUN VIOLENCE – Is UP 149% compared to 2020

- There was 1 shooting incident causing injuries to 1 individual and an additional victim suffered injuries in a homicide incident listed below for the week ending on 05/16/21.
 - There are a total of 66 incidents resulting in 87 victims YTD.
- There were 3 homicides the week ending on 05/16/2021
 - There are 16 homicides YTD
 - There were 3 homicides in April
 - There were 2 homicides in March
 - 7 of the 16 cases are cleared; 6 cleared by arrest, 1 cleared by exceptional = 44% Clearance YTD
