2. Amend Hearing Procedure: Separate discussion from deliberation.

Separate the members' discussion from their deliberation on the motion, with discussion proceeding the motion and deliberation after the motion is made

Chair Wolfe said the item was suggested by a member of the public.

The suggestion was: complainant presents facts and evidence for 5 minutes; other parties in support presents facts and evidence for 3 minutes; Respondent gets 5 minutes; respondent's supporters get 3 minutes; complainant rebuts for 3 minutes; public comment for 3 minutes; Task Force deliberates and questions may be asked of the complainant and respondent; respondent and complainant summarize and speak to facts and issues that came up during Task Force discussion for up to 2 minutes each; Task Force is open to motions with respect to the matter, with deliberation following each motion; and finally vote taken by Task Force.

Chair Wolfe said under current practice, the complainant or respondent cannot respond to new information discovered during Task Force deliberations.

Member Comstock suggested removing the 3-minute rebuttal. He also said the public should be allowed to testify on the motion.

It was then agreed to: complainant presents facts and evidence; parties in support presents facts and evidence; Respondent responds; supporters respond; Task Force in discussion at which time questions may be asked of the complainant and respondent; upon completion of the discussion; respondent and complainant summarize and speak to facts and issues that came up during Task Force discussion; Task Force is open to motions with respect to the matter, with deliberation following each motion; public comment; Task Force votes; public comment at discretion of chair on new motion if vote fails; and public comment at discretion of chair if new motion is made.
