5. **File No. 22129** Complaint filed by HVSafe against the Police Department for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.25, by failing to respond to an Immediate Disclosure Request for public records in a timely and/or complete manner.

Richard Johnson (HVSafe) (Petitioner) provided a summary of the complaint and requested the Committee to find a violation. Mr. Johnson stated that this originated from an October 2022 request for a recording from the Northern Station Police Department which was done by HVSafe and they are asking is to find out if the sign in sheets were being turned over to the Federal Government. under HVSafe. Mr. Johnson stated that issue is that this was a meeting hosted by the Northern Station Community and the information request is the email between Kaya of HVSafe and Captain Jackson of Northern Station. and they want a copy of the recording of that meeting. Mr. Johnson noted that HVSafe falls under the SOTF because of the level of funding by the City and if the sign in sheets are turned over to the Federal Government his privacy rights are violated.

Anonymous decided to not provide a statement.

Lt. William Toomey (Police Department) (Respondent), provided a summary of the department's position. Lt. Toomy stated that apologize to members of HV Safe for delay in responding to the request. Lt. Toomey stated that the Police Department does not regularly keep video recordings of community meetings at the Northern Station. Lt Toomey also noted that there are no emails between HVSafe and the Police Department discussing the participants in the community meetings. Lt. Toomey stated the request was made by the Petitioner to the Chief of Police and the captain of the Northern Station using the general email address which doesn't usually receive records requests. Mt. Toomey stated that once the request was found the provided the records in a timely response and after investigating, it was determined that they had no records and sent the requestor stating that.

A question and answer period occurred. The parties were provided an opportunity for rebuttals.

Action: Moved by Chair Hyland, seconded by Member Padmanabhan, to continue the matter to the call of the Chair and requests that an update be send to the Education, Outreach and Training Committee by February 3, 2023.
