5. **File No. 20008: Hearing on the Status of the Order of Determination:** Complaint filed by Anne Treboux against the Office of the City Attorney for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Sections 67.25 and 67.27, by failing to respond to an Immediate Disclosure Request in a timely and/or complete manner. (00:31:31)

Ann Treboux (Complainant) provided a summary of the complaint. Ms. Treboux stated that the documents that were turned over did not have the court stamp on them and therefore were not legal documents and not enforceable.

Jen Kwart, Director of Communications and Media Relations (Office of the City Attorney) (Respondent) provided a summary of the department's position and stated that they are only able to produce records that they have in their possession and had advised Ms. Treboux that she could request the records from the California Court of Appeal. Ms. Kwart further stated that the Sunshine Ordinance does not require them to seek out additional records from third parties and produce them to a requester.

A question-and-answer period occurred.
