1. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL, AND AGENDA CHANGES (00:01:13)

Chair LaHood called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. On the call of the roll, Chair LaHood and Members Anderson and Pilpel were noted present. Member Wolfe was absent. There was a quorum. Administrator Paticia Petersen was present.

5. **File No. 25018:** Complaint filed by Jonathan Balog against Office of Short-Term Rentals, SF Planning, for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.21 by failing to respond to a public records request in a timely and/or complete manner. (00:27:57)

(On 4/2/2025, the Task Force found a violation of Section 67.21 and ordered that by the terminology of the request, the request be responded to in full, including all of the property identification requested. The matter was referred to the Compliance and Amendments Committee for follow-up.)

Petitioner Jonahan Balog was not present.

Jonas Ionin (Respondent) was present.

The members discussed offering Mr. Ionin the opportunity to present the department's position.

- 6. **File No. 24022:** Complaint filed by Paul Kniha against the Municipal Transportation Agency for allegedly violating the Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.25, by failing to respond to an Immediate Disclosure Request in a timely and/or complete manner. (Items 6, 7 and 8 were called together at 00:34:37)
- 7. **File No. 24030:** Complaint filed by Paul Kniha against the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.25, by failing to respond to an Immediate Disclosure Request in a timely and/or complete manner.

8. **File No. 24036**: Complaint filed by Paul Kniha against the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.21 by failing to respond to a request for records in a timely and/or complete manner.

(On 1/28/2025, the Education, Outreach and Training Committee, hearing File Nos. 24022, 24030 and 24036 together, found that the Task Force has jurisdiction, that the records are public, and referred the matters to the full Task Force consent calendar.

The Committee further found that these public records per Section 67.21(L) are available and easily generated by the MTA and did not recommend a finding of a violation. However, the Committee requested that the MTA produce the transcripts from the March 29, April 26, and May 31, 2024 color curb hearings and send the transcripts to Mr. Kniha within 14 calendar days. The Committee further requested that the MTA produce future color curb hearing transcripts upon request. The Committee requested that the MTA propose a policy on transparency and transcripts for public-facing events, hearings, and meetings.

On 6/4/2025, the Task Force approved the Consent Agenda and accepted the recommendations of the Committee for File Nos. 24022, 24030 and 24036.)

Paul Kniha (Petitioner) stated that has received the videos when requested but has not received any transcripts. Mr. Kniha further stated the SFMTA released records in the past but no longer does so because doing so is "extra effort" although it is the same level of effort process-wise as producing a video.

The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (Respondent) was not present, having notified the Task Force on 6/18/2025 that knowledgeable representatives would not be available to attend this evening's meeting, that the availability of video/audio recordings had been considered and addressed, that the cost of producing accurate transcripts outweighs the potential benefit at this time, and requested that the Task Force resolve each complaint on the written record as long as their written responses demonstrate fully compliance with applicable law.
