4. **Hearing on Complaint Committee Administration** – Discuss Role in Advancing Expansion of SOTF Role per Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.30 Authorizations (00:04:16)

The Members discussed maintaining a list of recipients for media releases distinct from the distribution list kept pursuant to the Sunshine Ordinance requirement to notify members of the media of Special Meetings, identifying Committee projects, and discussing the distribution of initial hearings with the Task Force.

5. **File No. 24064:** Complaint filed by Matt Joseph against the Department of Building Inspection for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.21(k) by failing to release documentary public information, 67.26 by failing to disclose records in their entirety, and 67.27 by failing to provide justification for the withholding of information in writing. (00:20:22)

Matt Joseph (Petitioner) stated that the electronic duplicates provided by the Department of Building Inspection places end-user restrictions through the use of password-based PDF restrictions and watermarking, which prevents common actions such as copying text, using screen readers, and rotating or extracting pages and renders the records illegible. Mr. Joseph further stated that these facts are consistent for public records requests via any means, including NextRequest and the Department of Building Inspection's custom website form. Mr. Joseph stated that when restrictions have been removed on a document, it can be seen whether it has been encrypted.

Christopher J. Vergara (Respondent) stated that the use of watermarks and password protection is within the internal policy of the Department of Building Inspection and was developed under the guidance of the City Attorney to protect the integrity of the department's documents. Mr. Vergara further stated that on 12/5/2024 Petitioner was provided documents without watermarks or password protection.

Darren Wu (Respondent) stated that a non-watermarked document could be misused where customers have provided documents without watermarks but their source is unknown.

A question-and-answer period occurred.

Action: Moved by Vice-Chair Stein, seconded by Chair Schmidt, to find that the Task Force has jurisdiction over the matter, that the requested record(s) are public, and refer the matter to the full SOTF for consideration.

The Committee suggested that Petitioner provide a list of functions that are restricted due to Department of Building Inspection policies.
