ORDER OF DETERMINATION

CASE TITLE - File No. 20008

File No. 20008: Complaint filed by Ann Treboux against Dwight Moore and the Office of the City Attorney, for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Sections 67.25 and 67.27, by failing to respond to an Immediate Disclosure Request in a timely and/or complete manner.

HEARING AND ACTION ON THE COMPLAINT

On November 21, 2023, the Complaint Committee acting in its capacity to hear petitions/complaints heard the matter.

Action: Moved by Member Stein, seconded by Member Sugarman, to find that the requested records are public, the SOTF has jurisdiction, and referred the matter to the SOTF for consideration.

The matter shall be referred to the Compliance and Amendments Committee if the complainant states that they have not received their records.
