ORDER OF DETERMINATION

DATE DECISION ISSUED: 3/4/2026

File No. 26011: Complaint filed by HVSafe against the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.21, by failing to respond to a public records request in a timely and/or complete manner and Section(s) 67.25, by failing to respond to an immediate disclosure request in a timely and/or complete manner.

HEARING AND ACTION ON THE COMPLAINT

On 2/17/2026, the Complaint Committee, acting in its capacity to hear petitions/complaints, heard the matter.

Action: Moved by Member Sugarman, seconded by Vice-Chair Stein, to find that the Task Force has jurisdiction, that the requested records are public, and refers the matter to the SOTF Consent Agenda with a recommendation of a finding that the SFMTA violated Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.21(b), by failing to respond to a public records request in a timely manner. The Committee finds that the SFMTA did respond to the Immediate Disclosure Request but not in a complete manner and therefore finds no violation of Section 67.25.
