## ORDER OF DETERMINATION

DATE DECISION ISSUED: 3/4/2026

**File No. 26017:** Complaint filed by Michael Petrelis against the Office of the Mayor for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.29-5, by failing to respond to a request for Proposition G calendar in a complete manner.

### HEARING AND ACTION ON THE COMPLAINT

On 2/17/2026, the Complaint Committee, acting in its capacity to hear petitions/complaints, heard the matter.

**Action: Moved by Vice-Chair Stein, seconded by Chair Schmidt, to find that the Task Force has jurisdiction, that the requested records are public, and forwards the matter to the Consent Agenda with a recommendation to find no violation. The Mayor's Office did not violate the Prop G rules in listing that the Castro theater stakeholders were at a meeting rather than the individuals. 67.29-5 requires that calendar entries identify the individuals present and organization represented at a meeting or event only if the meeting has 10 or fewer attendees. Also, the mayor's office satisfied the law by acting in good faith by providing the full list of attendees as required by Section 67.29-5(e).**

On 3/4/2026, the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force held a hearing to review the recommendation from the Committee and/or review the merits of the petition/complaint.

**Action: Moved by Member Sugarman, seconded by Member Kumar, to approve Consent Agenda Item 14 (File No. 26017) and adopt the recommendations of the Committee, finding that the Mayor's Office did not violate Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.29-5, by failing to respond to a request for Proposition G calendar in a complete manner. The Committee found that Mayor's Office did not violate the Prop G rules in listing that the Castro theater stakeholders were at a meeting rather than the individuals, stating that Section(s) 67.29-5 requires that calendar entries identify the individuals present and organization represented at a meeting or event only if the meeting has 10 or fewer attendees. The Committee also found that the Mayor's Office satisfied the law by acting in good faith by providing the full list of attendees as required by Section 67.29-5(e).**
