 - File No. 210042 - [Hearing - Reimbursement Practices and Maximizing Funding - Youth and Family Mental Health Services] by Supervisor Melgar. It references DCYF so I think we should refer if we can. I can reach out to their office to see when they plan/hope to have the hearing scheduled (it's going to PS&N), as again if it's quite soon I doubt we'll be able to hear it given our next meeting is not till February
 - idea for feedback:
 - every year the YC passes a certain number of resolutions or motions on state legislation (fixed term season), they go through bills together and the YC has historically supported 3-4 SB legislation - to form an adhoc committee in YC (that Calvin will lead) that will meet 1-2 times and discuss which SB the YC would like to support
 - can be more seamless when the the SB actually released
 - Question: is anyone interested?
 - Commissioner Santos: i think its cool and it reminds me of the motion that commissioner ty brought to the FYC last year. I would like to support this, but not lead
 - Commissioner Zhang: yes i think its a great idea. I would like to support
 - Commissioners Asfaw & Hylton would like to participate as well
