


6. Department of Public Health MPX Affects on LGBTQ Youth (discussion item)

Vice Chair Barker Plummer: Are there any room issues due to pandemic rules?


Commissioner Utting: Is there anything that the commission can do to advocate for this?

Vice-Chair Barker Plummer: OAC seats, there were only two applicants. Moving forward, how can the Youth Commission help with the outreach and spread awareness of what these seats are?
