b. Discussion and Debrief of November 20, 2023 full Youth Commission Meeting

Vice Chair Listana said the meeting went well. She was glad that the LGBTQ+ Task Force was approved, the bylaws were amended, and the dialogue that took place on the legislation that was referred. Officer Fong said he was glad that Chair Barker Plummer made the motion because a lot of folks were able to make their voices heard. Commissioners were glad that there was perfect attendance at the meeting.

5. Public Comment on matters not on Today's Agenda (2 minutes per comment)

6. Committee Business (discussion and action item)

a. Community Builder

Vice Chair Listana asked how everyone's Thanksgiving break was and what they all did, and Commissioners answered the question and recalled their activities.

b. Review Commission Attendance

Director Garcia said that the attendance sheet is fully updated and that everyone is doing really well. She's also working to schedule the January 2024 meetings to make sure that everyone knows when they're happening. Vice Chair Listana also asked if commissioners would be able to attend the December 13th Executive Committee.

c. Updates on Commission Outreach and Communications

i. Presenters: Téa Lonné Amir & Kelly Wu, Communication and Outreach Officers

Officer Lonné Amir said they're still working on the Youth Commission outreach video and showed the Executive Committee the rough draft of the video, and that they're planning school site visits. She added that the Instagram posts on Youth



Commissioners should be posted soon, but that there's a lot going on right now so be patient.

Chair Barker Plummer asked if they're going to create an outreach plan on which schools to outreach to, to which Officer Lonné Amir said that they are having a meeting on Friday to plan it out.

- d. Updates on Recent Youth-Related Board of Supervisors / Mayor Legislation
 - i. Presenters: Allister Adair & Jason Fong, Legislative Affairs Officers

Officer Fong said there are two pieces of legislation referred to the Youth Commission currently, BOS File 230446, which will be on the Planning Code Zoning Map for Housing Production, and BOS File 231140, which Urges the Mayor to Initiate an Emergency Hiring Plan.

Officer Adair said he's glad that they have a speaker for the Youth Commission meeting on Monday, and that they'll be excited to pass both at that meeting. Chair Barker Plummer said that the Commission should keep in mind the timeline for legislation to pass, since the current timeline doesn't allow for turnaround time for the Board of Supervisors to fully read through the Youth Commission's response. YC Staff said that they can send it out on Monday evening to make sure the Clerk's Office can distribute that information in a timely manner.
