1. Call to Order and Roll Call for Attendance

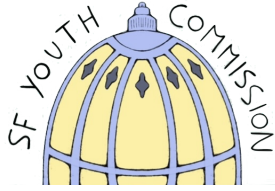
Chair Ye called the meeting to order at 5:10 pm.

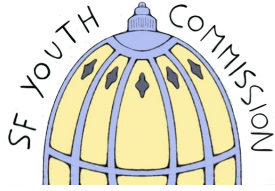
3. Approval of Agenda (Action Item)

There's concerns about the water park in Dog Patch due to contamination/toxic levels;
are residents in DogPatch know about the project, potential environmental/health
concerns regarding contamination

Vice Chair Dang brought up food deserts in the Dog Patch/Bayview Hunters Point
neighborhoods.

a. Goal Setting

The committee created the following goals for the year:

-Bayview Environmental Issue



- Work with community based organizations; like CASA and create new partnerships
- NARCAN Program established in all schools; specifically for SFUSD schools
- Substance Abuse Education and Prevention
- Sex-ed Curriculum (collaborate with CEEC)
- Human Trafficking Report and impacts on youth
- Immigration (resources for immigrant families)
- Student Success Fund
- Boys and Girls Club support
- YMCA support

Chair Ye talks about why her school has a Narcan Program and the need to have resources for this type of program in all schools

Vice Chair Dang spoke about human trafficking in San Francisco and incidents. Chair Ye had a conversation with a police officer about the need for sex-work for youth and human trafficking needs.

a. TJ-related Updates

YC Staff explains what TJ-related updated are and gave update on current collaboration with the Police Department.

Chair Ye announced the event from the Sugary Drinks Tax Advisory Council. Community Farm located in the Bayview; will forward information to Youth Commission
