7. Legislation Referred

a. BOS File No. 240699 - Ordinance - Site for New Library Branch - 100 Orizaba Avenue: Ordinance requiring that the new Public Library branch serving the Oceanview, Merced Heights, Ingleside, and Lakeview neighborhoods be built on the City-owned parcel of land at 100 Orizaba Avenue (Assessor's Parcel Block No. 7136, Lot No. 060), subject to environmental review, required approvals, and other applicable laws; and prohibiting the expenditure of City



funds to explore, pursue, or plan construction of a new Public Library branch serving those neighborhoods at any alternate location, except as required by the environmental review process, required approvals, or other applicable laws.

Commissioner Cisneros left the hearing room at 5:40 pm. Legislative Affairs Officers Adair and Fong explained the legislation referred to the full commission. Commissioner Cisneros came back to the hearing room at 5:44 pm. Commissioner Ye asked about which supervisors voted to support the first variation of the legislation. Commissioners discussed the various legislations regarding the library location. Commissioner Dang asked about the financial aspect and how it affects the legislation with other concerns about the location. Commissioner Ye asked about the concerns on the location and seeing if people are also not supporting the location.

Commissioner Barker Plummer, seconded by Commissioner Ye, motioned to not support the legislation. Commissioner Fong Commissioner Adair, motioned to support the legislation. Commissioner Barker Plummer explains the concerns of the library location and why the youth commission cannot support. Commissioner Adair and Commissioner Fond spoke in support of the legislation and the library location. Commissioner Perez asked about the input from D11 residents and surveying. Commissioner Dang spoke about them remembering key information from the D11 Office on the library location. Commissioner Ye spoke about additional concerns.

Commissioner Fong, seconded by Commissioner Dang, motioned to amend his original motion to table the item till the next meeting. Chair Barker Plummer explained he is not supporting this motion. Commissioner Dang asked for clarification. No Public Comment.

b. BOS File No. 240700 - Administrative Code - Clarifying Duties of Office of Victim and Witness Rights (OVWR); Moving Office of Sexual Harassment and Assault Response and Prevention to OVWR: Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to provide for the confidentiality of client information received by the Office of Victim and Witness Rights ("OVWR"); establish and clarify the responsibilities of OVWR; move the Office of Sexual Harassment and Assault Response and Prevention ("SHARP") from the Human Rights Commission to OVWR, and require SHARP to offer trauma-informed assistance to victims in navigating City processes, including by supporting victims in non-custodial law enforcement interviews, provided a SHARP employee's presence does not obstruct a police investigation or interfere with the District Attorney's investigative or prosecutorial function.

Legislative Affairs Officers Adair and Fong went over the legislation. Youth Development Specialist Zhang answered questions about the move of SHARP from HRC to OVWR. Commissioner Ye asked about Commissioner Barker Plummer discussed the needed investment to SHARP and OVWR.

Commissioner Barker Plummer, seconded by Commissioner Listana, motioned to support the legislation and with comments to continue the need to support SHARP and OVWR. No Discussion. No Public Comment. The motion carried by the following roll call vote:

BOS File No. 240706 - Hearing - Initiative Ordinance - Park Code - Parkway at Upper Great Highway: Hearing to consider the proposed Initiative Ordinance submitted by four or more Supervisors to the voters for the November 5, 2024, Election, entitled "Ordinance amending the Park Code to establish new recreation and open space by restricting private vehicles at all times on the Upper Great Highway between Lincoln Way and Sloat Boulevard, subject to the City obtaining certain required approvals; making associated findings under the California Vehicle Code; and reaffirming the existing restriction of private vehicles on the Great Highway Extension."
