d. TJ-related Updates

Chair Dang spoke about wanting to work on a resolution about gun violence. Commissioner Alameri is doing research on tenderloin kid safety zones and seeing how the committee can support their research. Director Esquivel Garcia spoke about connecting with the CAT Team. Chair Dang wants to ask the CAT Team "What are gonna be some drastic changes from the Lurie/Trump Administration?".
