a. Community Outreach Update

Chair Marlow is meeting with SF Parks Alliance on Wednesday. Commissioner Yang reached out to many CBOs for her BPPs. Vice Chair Kim will be working on getting a presentation from Richmond Neighborhood Center to present to the Full Commission. Commissioner Yang will work with staff to get MyPath to present to the Full Commission.

b. Review Resolutions

Chair Marlow and Commissioner Yang are working on a resolution on reducing plastic use by building off plastic reduction policies from SF Environment and overall aiming to reduce plastic waste in SFUSD. Commissioner Yang will also work on a motion to support for state legislative bill that's increasing climate education, a resolution of commendation for MyPath, and legislation on financial literacy.

Vice Chair Kim and Commissioner Yang will meet with SFUSD on March 19th for the school facilities.

The Committee reads and revises the resolution on school infrastructure.

Meeting attendees provide input on their school infrastructure situations.

c. Budget and Policy Priorities

Staff gives an overview of the prioritization discussion. Chair Marlow, Commissioner Yang, and Commissioner Liang think food insecurity should be prioritized. The Committee discusses the Youth Development Budget and Policy Priorities. CEEC will prioritize 1) Food Insecurity and 2) Youth Development.

Vice Chair Kim reports that SFUSD hired a new budget manager, and there seems to be more emphasis on efficiency over student needs. Commissioner Yang agrees and says that there's barely any communication from SFUSD.
