- b. CEEC-related Updates

Commissioner Conboy brings up a recent SF Chronicle article about Algebra I in middle school and an update on the curriculum implementation. Chair Yang expresses concern about the methodology used in the article.

## 8. Announcements (Informational)

Commissioner Elias is solidifying the plan for her resolution on media literacy and asks that it be agendized for the April 13th CEEC meeting. Vice Chair Marlow is wondering if she could do a resolution on the prevention of eating disorders and making services for eating disorder prevention accessible. Chair Yang suggests looking into DPH funding sources because Vice Chair Marlow says that these services generally fall under mental health services.

Chair Yang suggests that the Committee propose two resolutions for the April 13th meeting. Commissioner Conboy hears from youth in the community about school safety and security guards' attentiveness. Chair Yang expressed that the nuance of enforcing safety is complicated. Commissioner Moreno aims to address Title IX in SFUSD.

Commissioner Elias presented to Huckleberry Youth, and the youth at the programs are advocating for vape disposals in schools, more trash cans to eliminate street pollution, and addressing anti-homelessness infrastructure rather than investing in homelessness services.

Chair Yang talks about the presentation to MyPath on Thursday, from 5 - 7 PM. Chair Yang and Commissioners Elias and Conboy can attend. Commissioners Marlow and Moreno cannot attend.
