b. CBO Outreach Updates

Chair Mon hasn't heard from her CBOs in a while, but urges the Committee to follow up with the CBOs, especially for the Budget and Policy Priorities. Vice Chair Trujillo agrees and suggests sending a New Year's email to reconnect. Commissioner Lonné Amir hasn't heard from her CBOs in a while, but maintains a good relationship with her CBOs. Commissioner Mordehai provides an update of D1 Youth Council.

c. 2025/2026 Budget and Policy Priorities Discussion and Planning

The Committee members suggest connecting with JCYC to discuss youth employment programs. For the issue of youth drug prevention, the Committee recognizes that United Playaz is a good CBO to understand how the programs are going. Chair Mon suggests looking at the Sugary Drinks Distributors Tax Advisory Committee (SDDTAC) recommendations to address food insecurity. Commissioner Listana emphasizes on supporting immigrants as it's still very relevant, and Vice Chair Trujillo agrees and asks about meeting with legal service-providing CBOs. The Committee also wants to engage with the District Attorney's Office when addressing human trafficking concerns.

Commissioner Trujillo asks for data on shelters to understand the statistics relating to youth homelessness, such as for youth 18-24, under 18, and families with children under 18.

Chair Mon and Commissioner Listana ask the Committee what other departments and CBOs they should reach out to.

d. Teen Dating Violence Awareness and Prevention Month Resolution

Commissioners went over the resolution and timeline to introduce and vote on it. Commissioners agreed to request Supervisor Fielder to introduce a resolution with Supervisor Walton as primary secondary.

e. TJ-related Updates

Commissioner Mordehai asks to put a resolution relating to book bans on the Jan 22nd Transformative Justice Committee agenda.
