b. Timeline for Remainder of the Term

Chair Mon brings up a list of ideas from earlier in the term: workforce development, engaging with communities of color, increasing civic engagement, addressing gun violence, addressing sexual assault and harassment, and advocating for legal and financial literacy.

Commissioner Lonné Amir wants to look into state bills that the Committee can review. Staff mentions that this will be agendaized for the 04/23 TJ Committee meeting. Staff asked if the Committee wanted to do a TJ-specific community activity or field trip. Ideas include visiting Juvenile Hall, doing a United Playaz walk-through, understanding and visiting the Immigration Courts or Legal Centers, visiting a Rec&Park or SFUSD garden (Florence Fang Garden or Bayview Black Organic Farmers program). Commissioners expressed concern for General Civil Legal Service funding.

The Committee inquired about the SF Environment Youth Advisor Board and wanted to see how it's developing.

c. TJ-related Updates

Chair Mon and Commissioners discuss the budget cuts to SF YouthWorks. Commissioner Mordehai tells the Committee about her meeting at JJCC next week, and she'll do a report back at the next Committee meeting.
