- 6. Committee Business (Discussion)
- A) Upcoming Resolutions

I. Commissioner Pimentel and Chair Hum read the resolution into the record. Chair Loftus feels that the wellness centers aren't the most affection from her own personal experiences. Commissioner Pimentel responds that the wellness centers work depending on the individual. Chair Loftus recognizes that Commissioner Pimentel and Chair Hum are advocating for better-quality wellness centers. Chair Hum remarks that he needs to add Commissioners Barker Plummner and Nguyen to the sponsor names. Commissioner Barker Plummer provides grammatical edits. Later, Barker Plummer asks whether a further investment will make a difference in better wellness centers. Commissioner Loftus responds with her experience and sees the wellness centers and nurses' officers being the same thing in her own schools. Commissioner IM provides her experiences with the Lowell wellness centers but emphasizes that the wellness center should be separate from the nurses' officers. Chair Hum suggests a clause adding researching the disparity between schools. Commission Utting makes suggestions to the core part of the title. Commissioner Pimentel and Chair Hum will reintroduce an updated draft to the Committee at a later date.



II. Commissioner Pimentel and Chair Loftus preface the resolution draft. Commissioners Barker Plummer and Utting provide suggestions on whether financial literacy should be included with life skills or separated. Commissioner Utting offers to help with the resolution. Commissioner Barker Plummer asks about the third clause, and whether the data is international or national. Commissioner Pimentel responds that the data is national and they will make the clarification in the draft. Commissioner Utting recommends looking into college and career classes and adding this to their curriculum. Chair Hum teaches the financial literacy curriculum in the Lincoln HS JROTC, and Commissioner Im also teaches financial literacy in her organization. Both offer their connections to help.

III. Commissioner Barker Plummer is writing a letter of support for SB 691. Commissioner Im is working with Commissioners Utting and Wong on a resolution urging for better streamlining between SFUSD and CCSF.

Joy provided an update from YYAF Chair Ronen. The Committee compiled questions and issues they'll keep focus on during the hearing.

C) Vote16 Grant Update and Planning
