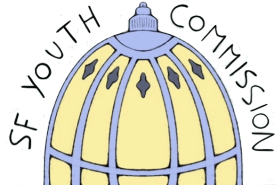
6. Committee Business (discussion & possible action)

a. Budget & Policy Priority Planning

Specialist Ochoa gave a brief explanation of the Budget & Policy Priority process, including the current budgetary outlook for next year, which is likely to be a difficult year for new programs or ideas.

Commissioners stated that the priorities for this upcoming budget year should include keeping the Free MUNI for all youth program, increasing the cleanliness of public transit, accessible and prioritized affordable housing for youth, expand access to recreational spaces, addressing vision zero, increasing the safety of self-driving cars, and rezoning and land use.

b. 2024 HRT Brainstorming



Chair Ansari and Commissioner Wong said that they wanted to see ways to reduce light pollution, and might be bringing that to the committee, in addition to all of the BPP planning topics listed above.

c. HRT-related Updates

Specialist Ochoa said that the housing element BOS legislation that the Youth Commission passed last week was passed at the Board of Supervisors level with 9 ayes and 2 nays.
