Specialist Ochoa let the Commissioners know about the celebration by Kid Safe SF on Sunday, April 28th for the 4th anniversary of the creation of JFK Promenade. There is also a "Connect Bay Area Act Launch Party" at 981 Mission St on Friday, April 26th, from 6pm to 8pm, in support of a 2026 regional ballot measure in support of public transit.

1 [Addressing West Portal Traffic Safety Changes]

2 Resolution supporting plans and highlighting concerns for a *Welcoming West* 

- 3 *Portal* which includes safety and community space improvements.
- 4 WHEREAS, Recent traffic incidents, specifically the tragic accident on March
- 5 16th at West Portal Avenue and Ulloa Street that resulted in the deaths of two children,
- 6 have highlighted an urgent need for enhanced traffic safety measures; and
- 7 WHEREAS, These incidents are indicative of broader traffic and public safety
- 8 issues within the West Portal community; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Motor vehicle collisions are the second-leading cause of death for

10 young people behind firearms, making the crash on March 16th part of a larger pattern

11 of traffic-related violence; and

WHEREAS, Young people from schools within the area are some of the most
frequent users of the West Portal corridor and utilize MUNI, the West Portal Library, and

- 14 other local resources on the weekends and after school; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The initial proposal draft includes the creation of transit only lanes,
- 16 protected community space, and only allowing right turns on certain streets to reduce
- 17 the amount of risk for pedestrians; and
- 18 WHEREAS, 40% of traffic deaths in San Francisco occur after drivers make left
- 19 turns; the proposal would remove two left turns and reduce the risk of collisions; and
- 20 WHEREAS, There is substantial community support for continued improvements
- 21 in traffic safety and public spaces, particularly in areas frequented by pedestrians and

22 cyclists; and

1	WHEREAS, Many businesses have expressed concern over the decrease in
2	private vehicle traffic that would result from the proposed changes; and
3	WHEREAS, Local community members, including staff at West Portal
4	Elementary School, have noted that the proposed changes could impact school drop-
5	offs and pickups, among other potential unforeseen traffic disruptions; and
6	WHEREAS, The current survey that the SFMTA released to the public is
7	convoluted and does not adequately give place for community members to fully
8	understand and provide feedback on the proposal; now, therefore be it
9	RESOLVED that the San Francisco Youth Commission supports the
10	development and implementation of safety and community space improvements in the
11	West Portal area; and, be it
12	FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Francisco Youth Commission supports the
13	addition of more bicycle parking facilities to promote safer and more sustainable
14	transportation options; and be it
15	FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Francisco Youth Commission urges the
16	inclusion of community and business input in the planning process to ensure that the
17	improvements meet the various needs of the West Portal community; and be it
18	FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Francisco Youth Commission recommends
19	careful consideration of traffic flow changes to avoid negatively impacting school drop-
20	offs and pickups; and, be it
21	FURTHER RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Youth Commission asks the
22	SFMTA to revamp the community input survey to be more easily understandable, with
23	the focus on the proposed improvements to the intersection; and, be it

- 1 FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 2 Mayor, the Board of Supervisors, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency,
- 3 and the District 7 Youth Council.


