Potential Citywide Programs

Playground Safety- Improve safety at playgrounds identified as D or F and at those with pressure-treated lumber

Restrooms- Continue funding for clean and safe restrooms

Water Conservation- Replace old, outdated irrigation with new permeable features and water efficient systems

Soil & Habitat Restoration- Improve eroding slopes and enhance connections to existing green space

Athletic Fields- Improvements to the city's natural play fields

Vistas & Access- Improvements to trails and surrounding landscape

Forestry- Address safety needs and replanting

Community Gardens- Upgrade and improve community gardens

Community Opportunity Fund- Continue smaller community-nominated projects as well as leveraging matching funds for larger projects
