| 13 | WHEREAS, In the City and County of San Francisco, 7,115 students were granted a                  |
| 14 | total of \$34,425,000 in Cal Grants for the 2010-2011 school year; and,                          |
| 15 | WHEREAS, Participation in the Cal Grant program and costs have increased since                   |
| 16 | 2004 from 177,000 students and \$688 million to an estimated 256,000 students and \$1.6          |
| 17 | billion in the upcoming year; <sup>2</sup> and,  |
| 18 | WHEREAS, Governor Brown's proposed budget for 2012-2013 includes a reduction in                  |
| 19 | funding for the Cal Grant program by \$131.2 million, which will be achieved by increasing the   |
| 20 | minimum GPA requirement for Cal Grant in the following way: for Cal Grant A from 3.0 to          |
| 21 | 3.25; for Cal Grant B from 2.0 to 2.75; and for community college transfers from 2.4 to 2.75—    |
