15	Chavez," "Supporting Affordable Housing," and "Urging San Francisco to Defer on Potential Road
16	Closures within Golden Gate Park;" and
17 18	WHEREAS, The topics he advocated for remain relevant today, inspiring today's Youth
19	Commissioners to advocate for the many priorities Mayor Arreguin once did; and
20	WHEREAS, Then-Youth Commissioner Arreguin was elected Government Affairs Officer by his
21	peers, instilling leadership through community, and advising his colleagues on the pending legislation;

23	WHEREAS, Then-Youth Commissioner Arreguin proved through action his unshakeable
24	commitment to public service and the betterment of lives, a commitment he now continues as Mayor of
25	Berkeley; now therefore be it
