

[Motion to Submit Letter of Support for AB 932]

Motion to urge the Board of Supervisors and Mayor to support California

Legislative Bill AB 932.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Youth Commission is a chartered body in the City and County of San Francisco that represents the needs and voices of youth; and

WHEREAS AB 932 (Irwin) would prohibit a local educational agency (LEA) from discriminating against community youth athletic programs in the allocation or rental of school and recreation facilities and resources on the basis of sex or gender; and

WHEREAS, The bill would also create a new requirement for contractors and subcontractors to develop and implement compliance plans, as specified, and expand the list of potential sanctions for violations of these provision; and

WHEREAS, 63% of youth in San Francisco play sports at least one day a week, according to Aspen Institute's Project Play. Ensuring they all have equal and fair access to sport facilities regardless of their sex and/or gender; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Youth Commission believes in fair and equitable opportunities for all youth in San Francisco regardless of one's sex and/or gender; and therefore be it

MOVED, That the San Francisco Youth Commission hereby urges the Mayor and Board of Supervisors to urge the State Legislature to support AB 381; and be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the San Francisco Youth Commission urges the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors to fight for all youth in San Francisco to have equal access to sports facilities regardless of their gender and or/ sex.
