

[Gun Violence Awareness Rally]

Motion to Recognize June 6, 2025 as Gun Violence Awareness Day and Co-Host the Gun Violence Awareness Day Rally at San Francisco City Hall.

WHEREAS, Gun Violence Awareness Day was established on June 6th after the tragic death of Hadiya Pendleton, a young girl killed by a stray bullet, and is now a nationwide movement to end gun violence; and

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Youth Commission (SFYC) is committed to representing the interests, perspectives, and needs of youth in San Francisco and ensuring they have a voice in public policy decisions affecting their lives; and

WHEREAS, the SFYC over the past few years has advocated on ending gun violence by including it in their annual Budget and Policy Priorities report; and therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Youth Commission hereby recognizes June 6th, 2025, as Gun Violence Awareness Day; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Youth Commission join as official co-host with other partners to host a rally in front of City Hall to recognize June 6th as Gun Violence Awareness Day.
