4. Approval of Minutes (Action Item)

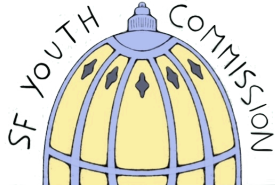
a. January 30, 2024 (Packet Materials)

Commissioner Barker Plummer showed appreciation to the presenters but emphasized getting more infrastructure funding. Chair Alioto-Pier wants to emphasize on mental health of the students. Commissioner Barker Plummer says that he's glad that it caught the attention of the Supervisors.

c. Budget and Policy Priorities (BPP)

Chair Alioto-Pier asks if the Committee knows about doing footnotes in Chicago format. The Committee looks over the Vote16 BPP and there are not many changes.

School Safety
