**1. Call to Order and Roll Call for Attendance**

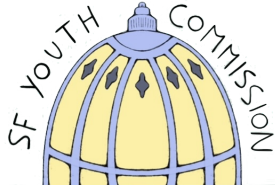
Chair Alioto-Pier called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

b. District 7 Youth Council Presentation

Commissioner Fong approached Chair Alioto-Pier about a D7 Youth Council Vote16 presentation from the SF Youth Commission's Civic Engagement and Education Committee.
