The organization has food pantries that serve seniors and youth, and the District has lots of food insecurity issues. Thus, Vice Chair Kim wants to uplift this issue. The Richmond Neighborhood Center program manager is open to talking to the Youth Commission on food insecurity issues. The organization is working on getting more youth to attend the RCC quarterly meetings.

The Committee wants to get support for people on the Westside facing homelessness and food insecurity, while not discrediting the severity of the same issues on the Eastside.
