1. Call to Order and Roll Call for Attendance

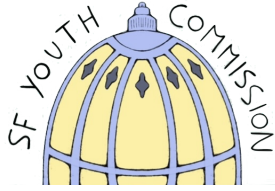
Chair Alioto-Pier called the meeting to order at 6:13 pm.

4. Approval of Minutes (Action Item)

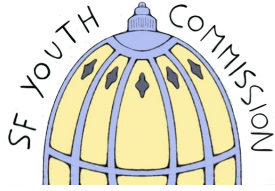
a. November 27, 2023 (Packet Materials)

8. Committee Business (discussion and action item)

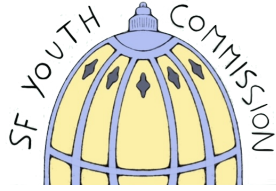
a. Review Talking Points
