**1. Call to Order and Roll Call for Attendance**

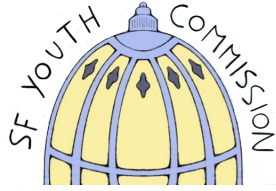
Chair Barker Plummer called the meeting to order at 5:02pm.

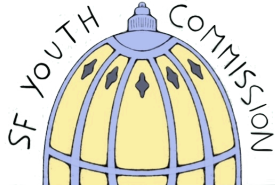
Alondra Esquivel Garcia, Director of the SFYC, shared communications and meeting announcements with the Executive Committee.

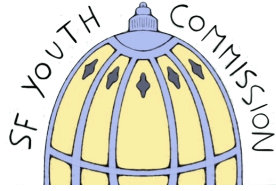
