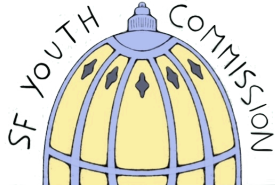

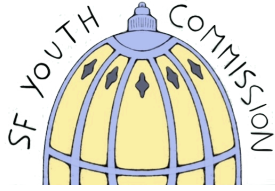

The committee discussed state legislation. They discussed SB 1288, SB 1078, and AB 1975. They wanted to hear more information at the next meeting about each legislation.

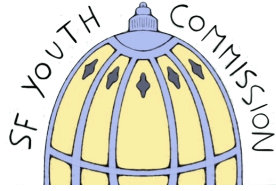
### **DCYF RFP Decision and Process**
